These visits aim to provide school principals with firsthand exposure to best practices, facilitate potential collaborations for integrating Skill (Vocational) Education into mainstream education, and familiarize them with emerging trends through interactive and experiential learning.

Participation is subject to prior email confirmation. TA/DA bills, along with supporting documents and a one-page visit report, must be submitted in hard copy within 10 days of completion of the visit; bills submitted late or electronically will not be accepted.
