Guidelines for Drawing

- The work must be on a flat piece of A3 size paper (any variety/quality paper) with 1 cm external border.
- Each individual can submit only one piece of work in each category, and the work should be his/her original work. Drawing(s) copied from the internet will not be accepted.
- Acceptable tools for Drawing: color pencils, crayons, oil pastel, sketch pens, water color, oil paint, acrylic etc.
- The artwork must not represent national flag, any particular individual, organization, or brand name and must not depict any religious theme.
- Artwork incompatible with the above guidelines will not be considered.

Guidelines for Cyber Security slogans

- The slogan should be a one-line sentence or phrase that is catchy and relevant to the theme of information security.
 - Example: "Be Cyber Aware Be Cyber Secured"
- Each individual can submit only one Slogan, and it should be his/her original work.

 Slogans copied from the internet will not be accepted / encouraged
- The slogan should not have any negative connotations pointing out individual, organization, brand name, religion, country etc.,
- It should be a motivating and positive quote or sentence that encourages awareness among citizens regarding any aspect of cyber security.
