SkillsBuild Program & Orientation Session on Generative AI in collaboration with IBM

Artificial Intelligence (AI) has rapidly evolved from a futuristic concept to a ubiquitous technology that impacts our daily lives. Thus, creating a need for the youth to understand AI's importance and responsible usage.
